Duration: Three days.

Course overview:

With a focus on the role of supervision, learners will develop the essential knowledge and understanding to enable them to discharge health and safety responsibilities.

Upon completion of this course delegates will understand their roles and responsibilities for the health and safety of others, as well as be able to effectively shape management processes and procedures designed to ensure the safety of your employees.
