



IOSH Managing Safely v5.

Duration: Four or five days.

Course overview:

The Institute of Occupational Safety and Health's *Managing safely* is for managers and supervisors in any sector, and any organisation. It's designed to get managers up to speed on the practical actions they need to take to handle health and safety in their teams.

Managing safely won't turn learners into health and safety experts . but it will give them the knowledge and tools to tackle the health and safety issues they're responsible for. Importantly . it brings home why health and safety is such an essential part of their job.

Learning aims:

To give managers and supervisors an understanding of everyone's safety and health responsibilities in the workplace. To enable managers and supervisors to recognise how they can influence, control and monitor risk to improve safety and health issues in the workplace.

Learning outcomes:

The learner will be able to:

- 1 Describe the key reasons to manage safety and health in the workplace.
- 2 Define the key terms relating to safety and health.
- 3 Identify how the law can have an impact on safety and health in the workplace.
- 4 Describe how to assess, reduce and control risk in the workplace.
- 5 Identify workplace hazards and risks, their impact and how to manage them.
- 6 Identify how to evaluate and respond to an incident.
- 7 List the benefits and characteristics of an effective health and safety management system.
- 8 Describe the principles that underpin good safety and health performance.

Four day: Examination (30 question, multi-format assessment) on the final day plus a risk assessment based project to be returned within two weeks after course completion.

Five day: Examination and project completed on-site on the final day.
